

Setting up a View Printer Quick Reference Guide

This document assists users who wish to view *Maestro* reports on the screen, even if they do not have a printer that is supported by Terminal Services.

- Start > Settings > Printers OR Start > Printers
- Printer > Add a printer

Screen Name	What you do
Welcome to the Add Printer Wizard	 Next
Local or Network Printers	 Select "Local Printer Attached to this Computer" Deselect "Automatically detect & install my Plug and Play printer" Next
Select a Printer Port	LPT1: (Recommended Printer Port)Next
Install Printer Software	Manufacturer (left side)Printers (right side)Select GenericSelect Generic/Text Only
Name your Printer	 "Generic/Text Only" appears in the Printer name box "Do you want to use this printer as the default printer?" Yes * Next * Terminal Services only looks at your default printer.
Printer Sharing	Select "Do not share this printer"Next
If the Location and Comment screen appears	Leave it blankNext
Print test page	NoNext
Completing the Add Printer Wizard	 Finish

Once you have this printer set up, log into Terminal Server and then into Maestro. There is a delay while Terminal Services looks for your default printer.

Note: If you need to print something from your local desktop (not *Maestro*) you will need to change the default to your attached printer.
