

Maestro Club Membership Card Printing Notes

Date: October 15

Background

The Maestro Club Member module has been enhanced to incorporate the addition and tracking of Members.

There are facilities within Club Member Maintenance to facilitate the necessary setup and configuration for Members. The Club Member program then includes facilities to manage Members.

Part of the process for managing Members is the allocation and generation of Membership Cards.

The physical printing and mag stripe encoding of Membership Cards has been achieved by the use of 3rd party software: EPI Builder 6 from Image Ware Systems. This 3rd party software is a COM interface and the solution works only for Windows installations.

Printing of cards is dependent on the availability of a suitable Card Printer. For test purposes Northwind have used a Fargo Direct Card 400.

EPI Builder Interface

The EPI software includes the print interface and also an EPI Designer application, used for the design of membership cards.

Three license types are involved with this software:

- 1. EPI Designer License
- 2. Developer License
- 3. Runtime License

The EPI Designer is required to run the EPI Designer application. This application is required for the design of the Membership Card Layout.

Membership Card Layout includes the inclusion and positioning of static background images, member specific images and member specific text for both printing and encoding. It allows for the definition of image and text data fields, used by the Maestro application when passing data to the EPI interface.

The EPI Designer application creates a DGN file, passed as a parameter from Maestro to the EPI interface.

Northwind Management will need to decide on whether to purchase an EPI Designer license. This license will give Northwind the ability to provide Membership Card Design services to their clients. It will also provide a level of control so that member cards layouts contain the fields required in the Maestro interface.

The Runtime license is required for printing membership cards. It is likely to be necessary at all client locations where membership card printing is required.





The following Maestro fields are passed as parameters to the EPI interface. The required fields should be included in the DGN file:

Maestro Setup

The Club Member Maintenance System Options program has two new fields that must be populated: Layout Folder and Image Folder.

The folders must contain a valid, existing folder name, where DGN Layout files and Member Images files respectively will be stored.

The Member Cards screen enables the creation of Membership Cards for a Member. The user must enter a member card number, directly or via a card swipe (if the card has been pre-encoded).

The user must enter a Layout Filename for the membership card and optionally an image filename to be printed on the card.

There is then a drop down menu option that enables the Membership Card to be printed
